The Buddha Blessed Temple, a religious non-profit organization, celebrates its Grand Opening at its newly constructed center, 7748 Third Street Road, Louisville, KY 40214. This milestone event is open to the public, with FREE admission, parking, and other unique activities, including: keynote addresses by Louisville Mayor Greg Fischer, US Attorney Russell Coleman, and Buddhist clergy; ribbon cutting ceremony; and special features of the Vietnamese and Buddhist cultural, culinary, and spiritual traditions.

The Buddha Blessed Temple began in 2006 under the leadership of its founder, Dr. Rev. Thich Hang Dat, a professor at Indiana University Southeast in Indiana, and University of Houston in Texas. Due to the spiritual demand and inquiry of the local community, after the center acquired 15.5 acres of land in 2016, in early Spring 2018, it started to construct a largest Buddhist center in the Midwest with a 14,000-square-feet building, and it completed the construction project in Summer 2019.
